The Draft 2015 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) is now available for your review and comment at the following link:

The 2015 FSTIP is a federally mandated document prepared by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) every two years in cooperation with the metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) and the regional transportation planning agencies. It contains identified phases of all capital and non-capital transportation projects prioritized to receive federal funding under Titles 23 and 49 of the United States Code during federal fiscal years 2014/15 through 2017/18. This document also includes regionally significant projects regardless of their funding source.


Each of the state's eighteen MPOs prepares a Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP), which includes a listing of projects within that MPO's boundary. The FSTIP references these FTIPs and includes a listing of projects in rural areas outside of MPOs' boundaries. The attached table provides links to MPOs' FTIPs.
