

Annual Listing of Obligated Projects

Federal law, Title 23 CFR §450.334, requires that the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG), as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the six county transportation commissions (CTCs) region of Imperial, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura, publish a listing of projects that obligated federal transportation funds in the previous federal fiscal year.

In accordance with 23 CFR §450.334, the State, CTCs, public transportation operators, and SCAG cooperatively develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under 23 U.S.C. or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated in the preceding program year. The listing includes all federally funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the preceding program year.

In the SCAG region, the CTCs, in communication and collaboration with local agencies, public transportation operators and the public, work to develop their respective county transportation improvement program through SCAG's Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) database. SCAG, in consultation and coordination with the State, CTCs, along with public transportation operators, uses the FTIP database to compile the obligation information to produce and publish the annual listing of projects according to public participation criteria for the FTIP. Note: Projects included in the Annual Listing of Federally Obligated Projects may have additional federal funds programmed in future fiscal years of the FTIP. The following detailed project listing report outlines projects which received federal obligations in federal fiscal year 2016. Total obligations for the SCAG region was over \$2.3 billion.
