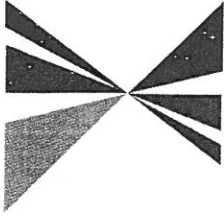

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) is transmitting the Federal Transit Administration Section 5307 Transit Improvement Comprehensive Report. The report includes grantees that were awarded a grant in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2013 in which a portion of the award is for transit improvements. Please note that discussions regarding the Public Employees' Pension Reform Act of 2013 (PEPRA) between the Department of Labor and the State of California reduced the number of obligated grants in the region resulting in the drop of transit improvement obligations for FFY 2013. Several grants are currently under review and it is anticipated that the 1% for transit improvements will increase to normal levels in future fiscal years.

The report includes the five urbanized areas in which SCAG is the designated recipient. The urbanized areas are:

- Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim
- Riverside-San Bernardino
- Murrieta-Temecula-Meniffee
- Indio-Cathedral City
- Lancaster-Palmdale
