MEETING SUMMARY

1. CALL TO ORDER AND SELF-INTRODUCTIONS

Lori Huddleston, TCWG Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The Chair acknowledged two comment letters that were posted and distributed to the TCWG regarding Item 4.1-1: RIV090903.

Karen Calderon, SCAG, noted that a third comment letter was received for Item 4.1-1: RIV090903. The comment letter was posted on SCAG's website and distributed to the TCWG during the meeting.

Mike McCarthy, Sierra Club, provided a public comment for Item 4.1-4: RIV090903.

- 4.1. Review of PM Hot Spot Analysis Interagency Review Form
 - Attachment 4.1-1: RIV090903: It was determined that this project is not a project of air quality concern.

For future projects seeking re-concurrence from TCWG, U.S. EPA staff emphasized the importance of using the latest planning assumptions—particularly updated Level of Service (LOS) and Average Daily Traffic (ADT) figures—if a significant amount of time has passed since the original traffic data were validated.

Shea Northfield, SCAG, reported no updates.

4.3. FTIP Update

Shea Northfield, SCAG, reported the following:

- SCAG staff was meeting with CTCs staff to go over major changes to the draft 2027 FTIP Guidelines. Major changes
 would also be shared with Caltrans, FHWA, and FTA Liaisons before finalizing and presenting to SCAG's
 Transportation Committee and Regional Council in September 2025.
- 2025 FTIP Administrative Modification #25-11 was being finalized by SCAG staff.
- 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-12 would be posted for a 10-day public review and comment period. Email notices would be sent to TCWG.
- 2025 FTIP Administrative Modification #25-13 was due to SCAG staff on August 12, 2025.
- County Transportation Commissions prioritization rankings for SCAG's STBG/CMAQ funding cycle were due to SCAG staff on August 1, 2025. Award recommendations would be presented to the SCAG Regional Council by December 2025.

4.6. Air Districts Updates

- 4.6.1. Ventura County APCD Update

 No representative was present to provide updates.
- 4.6.2. South Coast AQMD Update Sang-Mi Lee, South Coast AQMD, reported no updates.
- 4.6.3. Mojave Desert AQMD Update
 Michelle Zumwalt, Mojave Desert AQMD, reported no updates.
 - 4.6.3.1. Status Update on the Mojave Desert AQMD Litigation against U.S. EPA Michelle Zumwalt, Mojave Desert AQMD, reported the following:
 - The Mojave Desert AQMD, through CARB, submitted a commitment letter to U.S. EPA to modify its New Source Review (NSR) rule in order to pause the highway sanction clock, which was set to go into effect July 31, 2025.
 - U.S. EPA indicated agreement with the proposed modifications; however, U.S. EPA action was still
 pending.

Rodney Tavitas, Caltrans HQ, added that the master highway sanction project list was submitted to FHWA and U.S. EPA prior to U.S. EPA action to help mitigate potential project delays under highway sanction if it were to be imposed.

- 4.6.4. Antelope Valley AQMD Update
 Barbara Lods, Antelope Valley AQMD, reported no updates.
 - 4.6.4.1. Status Update on the Antelope Valley AQMD Litigation against U.S. EPA Barbara Lods, Antelope Valley AQMD, reported the following:
 - U.S. EPA published a limited approval/disapproval on Rule 1314, part of the Antelope Valley AQMD's NSR rules and concurrently made an interim final determination to defer the highway sanction clock in April 2025.
 - To address the new proposed limited disapproval, Antelope Valley AQMD staff amended and then its Governing Board adopted the NSR rule during their July 15, 2025 meeting.
 - The amended rule would be resubmitted to U.S. EPA through CARB for approval by the end of July, with the goal of obtaining full approval of the NSR package and permanent relief from sanctions.
